Visitors entering and leaving company premises are kindly requested

- to carry their day pass visibly on them;
- to wear a warning vest;
- to wear safety helmets in areas of suspended loads passing overhead;
- to keep entry permits at a visible place in the vehicle;
- to return day pass and entry permits at the reception when leaving the factory.


The following restrictions must be observed throughout our premises

-  Smoking allowed in identified areas only.
-  No fire and open flame allowed.
-  Do not touch machines, conveyor belts, and other materials.
-  Use mobile phones in the production area in cases of emergency only.
-  No photographs to be taken at company premises. Please respect our customers' copyrights.
-  Production areas, laboratories and storage areas to be entered with prior notice/permit only.

Safety instructions and rules of conduct


-  Caution! – hazardous materials used at the factory.
-  Beware of fork and high lift truck traffic! In most areas, there are no separate passages for pedestrians and vehicles.
-  Beware of crane transports! Do not cross under suspended loads passing overhead. In these areas safety helmets are mandatory!
